

Character Education Lesson Plans – Fall/Winter 2015

Focus: The following lesson plan is designed to help teach students about bullying identification, bullying prevention, recognizing the difference between conflicts and bullying, and learning to help by reporting bullying.

Goals:

- Students will learn what to do when they see bullying or are being bullied.
- Students will learn to differentiate bullying from daily conflict situations everyone faces.
- Students will learn to identify the difference between telling and tattling.
- Students will understand how to effectively report bullying to obtain adult help.
